

Information for holidays with your horse at Field Farm.

Field Farm has been set up specifically to provide accommodation and equestrian facilities for riders and their horses whilst on holiday here with us.

2-night minimum Cottages and Caravans
1-night minimum Geodomes and Camping

Horse Transport Parking

Parking for all horse vehicles, lorries and trailers is in our parking field. This is left at the big stop sign, please reverse your trailers/lorries to the fence. If you are staying in your horsebox or trailer, then this can be set up in a designated bay on our camping field. No horses to be unloaded or loaded on hard standing car park area near reception.

Human Accommodation.

We have a camping / horse lorry area with optional electric hook up points. There are toilets and showers adjacent to this area along with an area for washing pots and pans etc. The Camping field is adjacent to our horse paddock area. We welcome lorries, trailers, tents, motorhomes, campers, tourers and tentboxes. Sleeping in cars is not permitted. Your camp space is for 1 item (as listed) and an awning. The price is for upto 4 people, extra people are charged at £10pppn. Additional items stayed in will be charged the camping prices.

We have two sizes of holiday home (static caravans), The Paddocks, Lake View and The Meadows are both a maximum 8 person with one double bedroom, two twin bedrooms and a further double created by converting the dining area, and Woodlands/Silverbirch holiday home is a maximum 6 person with one double bedroom and two twin bedrooms.

We also have two sizes of holiday cottage. The Hayloft and The Granary are both a maximum of 6 person with two bedrooms and a sofa bed. There are also three 4 person holiday cottages, The Piggery, Hill Holt and The Parlour each has one bedroom and a sofa bed.

All holiday homes and cottages are equipped for self catering breaks and include bed linen. They each have oven, hob, grill, microwave, toaster, cutlery, pots and pans, crockery, glasses, fridge freezer, tv, shower and wc. You will need to bring your own towels, as we do not supply these for hygiene reasons.

Hot tubs are available to book with cottages. They are charged at £50 per night minimum 2 nights, prebooking is essential so it can be ready for your arrival.

Geodomes Daphne, Delilah, and Dotty all sleep 2 people. They have a double bed, electricity, fairy lights, small seating area, TV, heater. Outside they each have a cooking hut with small oven/hob, fridge freezer, all pots, pans and utensils. They have an outdoor seating area equipped with a log fire (logs can be purchased at reception)

Daisy, Darcey, Dory all sleep up to 4 people, they have 2 single beds, 1 double bed, tv, log fire, heater, fairy lights, sofa. Outside they each have a cooking hut with small oven/hob, fridge freezer, all pots, pans and utensils. They have an outdoor seating area equipped with a log fire (logs can be purchased at reception). You will need to bring your own towels, as we do not supply these for hygiene reasons.

Geodomes have access to the toilet and shower block located next to the reception.

For all accommodation on departure day please place used bedding in the linen bags provided, wash and put away any used pots, and removed empty bin bags put these in the bins provided on the car park.

We welcome well behaved dogs and allow them in the holiday homes and cottages or with campers. The cost is £10.00 per dog per night. **DOGS MUST BE BOOKED PRIOR TO ARRIVAL.** Our rules are simple, please keep dogs off the beds and soft furnishings, housing them in a transport crate and clean up after them. **A £50 FEE WILL BE INCURRED IF FURNITURE/BEDDING IS DESTROYED/ DIRTY.**

Holiday homes are available from 3.00pm on the day of arrival and need to be vacated by 11.00am on the day of departure, this allows us a minimum of 4 hours to change bedding and clean through between guests. You can arrive from 2pm, please do not arrive before this time to enable us to have a full clean changeover (early arrival option is available at booking, this allows you access to a paddock and the riding facilities from 10.30am- this does not allow you access to the accommodation) You must vacate stables, paddocks and accommodation by 11am on departure day. You can tie up at your transport if you wish to stay and use the facilities. Stables will be available from 2pm on arrival and need to be vacated by 11am on departure day. A paddock may be available but not guaranteed. (subject to availability)

You may be issued a cottage/caravan itinerary on arrival you will be required to check that all of the items on the list are there and sign to approve. We are aware that accidents happen but we ask that any breakages are paid for before departure.

We have onsite café- Cavalla. Serving breakfasts, pizzas, gyros, burgers, ice creams, waffles and doughnuts. Opening times available on the café door each day, pre order service is sometimes required.

There are a number of local restaurants and takeaways that will deliver to the farm including pizza / kebab, Indian restaurant, Chinese and Italian.

We have a well stocked fishing lake adjacent to the camping field which is free to use for guests here on holiday. Please do not swim in the lake, children must be supervised at all times around the lake.

Play park area

We have a small park area for the younger children to enjoy, please supervise children. We accept no liability for injury sustained whilst playing on the park or surrounding areas.

Bikes/Scooters

Please do not ride bikes or scooters in the horse areas. (I.e stable areas, on the main yard)

Horse Accommodation.

Stable/Paddock option includes hay, straw, use of all facilities, show jump arena, dressage arena, cross country course, indoor lunge/small riding area, wash down area.

Paddock only option includes hay, use of all facilities, show jump arena, dressage arena, cross country course, indoor lunge/small riding area, wash down area.

You do not need to book any of our facilities you have unlimited use for duration of your stay.

On departure all stables must be completely emptied, all paddocks poo picked and all hay removed.

All horses MUST be vaccinated, if your horse has been in contact with any infectious diseases then be a responsible owner and do not put other horses at risk. You must bring proof of vaccinations for each horse that you are bringing. No vaccinations, no access. You will be asked to leave if you cannot provide the required information, no refunds will be given.

If you have booked a stable, please use this for tacking up to leave the tie up areas free for people who have paddocks only. For paddock only spaces please use your horse transport, your field or the tie ups provided to tack up. Once used please remove your possessions to allow others to use them if required.

All mucking out equipment is provided as are brushes, forks etc. Feed/water buckets are not provided and will need to be brought with you if needed. Barrow covers are provided for transporting hay/ straw around the yard and to the paddocks.

Regular disinfection of the yard and surrounding areas takes place at various times throughout the day, please ensure possessions are either in the designated tack rooms provided or in your vehicles. Fire extinguishers are available at different points on the yard in the event of an emergency.

Vet and farrier numbers are available on the board in the utensils rooms, as are the daily tide times for the beach.

Horse Facilities

On site we have a 60mx 35m show jumping arena with a range of jump for joy show jumps on a fibretrak surface

40mx25m schooling arena on a fibretrak surface

1.3 mile cross country course with various jumps ranging from 40cm-90/1.05cm, each jump is optional. We have a water complex, Normandy bank, ditches, logs, steps etc.

4 bay wash down area with a complementary shampoo bar

Indoor lunge area/ small riding area

You can ride around the perimeter of our fields, suitable for a gentle ride or some canters if you wish

Quiet lane hacking locally, or Well Vale is a short drive away this is 9 mile off road hack with additional cross country course (charges apply)

The beach is accessed via a green lane just over 1 mile long, and then 250 yards of quiet coastal road. The beach we access is Wolla Bank, you can park vehicles there (no horseboxes/trailers) payment is required. You ride on the beach at low tide, you have 2 hours before until 2 hours after low tide to ride on the beach. Wolla Bank is dog friendly. Leave only your footsteps and hoof prints- no rubbish!

All facilities are included for the duration of your stay, no booking is required.

Tack and Country Store

We have a small onsite tack/treat shop

Field Farm Merch- hoodies and t shirts

Human provisions - crisps, cakes, biscuits, chocolate bars, bottled water, Soft drinks and fizzy drinks.

Horse treats – 100 gram, 500 gram and 1kg bags of multi vitamin horse treats and training aids.

Horse tack – basic range of items in case you lose or forget something or maybe just want to treat yourself

Cleaning / first aid – great range of tack and horse cleaning lotions and potions, fly sprays and gels, wound creams and lotions, vet wrap, gamgee's etc

Payment Details

To confirm a booking we require a 30% non refundable deposit. The balance is then paid 6 weeks before your holiday to Field Farm and posted to Field Farm, Ember Lane, Langham Road, Mumby, Alford, Lincolnshire, LN13 9SL via your confirmation email, you can pay by card, BACS or paypal
